

# CAUTION

The WAVE LED UV Magnifier emits ultraviolet (UV-A) or long-wave light during operation.

While such light is not in the harmful range of the ultraviolet spectrum, proper care should always be exercised with any ultraviolet product. An ultraviolet product should only be used by individuals familiar with proper usage and aware of potential hazards.

As with any ultraviolet product, the following recommendations apply:

- Hands should be properly protected with UV resistant gloves.
- Eyes should be properly protected with a face shield, visor, goggles or spectacles which absorb UV.
- As a general rule, do not look directly at a UV lamp.
- Unnecessary or long-term exposure, in close proximity, should be avoided.
- Certain medications and chemicals may increase an individual's sensitivity to ultraviolet light. Individuals who are photosensitive may have an increased susceptibility to eye or skin irritation caused by UV. For specific information, consult your physician.
